South Carolina Greenville district, Know all men by these Presents that I William Nelson of the State and district aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by Joseph Nelson of the State & district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release to the said Joseph Nelson all that tract of land lying in Greenville district on Wildcat Creek of South Tiger river, begining on a Red oak, thence South along the said line, one half length of said line, then across to the East line thence north to a Conditional corner a Stake made between s^r Joseph Nelson & Robert Nelson thence north along a Conditional line to the north line, thence West along s^r line to the beginning red oak, Containing 70 acres the same being part of a two hundred acre tract of land granted to John Lucas by his executors Benjamin Fuer and others bearing date January the 25th 1785, & from s^r Lucas conveyed to John Childress, and from s^r Childress to Robert Nelson, & from s^r Rob^t Nelson conveyed to William Nelson, & from Mr. Nelson to Joseph Nelson — Also a thirty acre tract of land, Conveyed by John Lucas to W^m Nelson, of same original grant, begining on a Stake on Wild Cat Creek a Conditional corner made between John Lucas & W^m Nelson thence down s^r Creek to the mouth of a branch, thence up the meanders of said Branch to the head is a conditional corner on a white oak, thence on a Conditional line to the East line to a red oak a conditional corner on the East line, thence north to a red oak, thence West to the beginning, TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining; to have & to hold the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph Nelson his heirs & assigns forever. & I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & administrators, to Warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises to the s^r Joseph Nelson his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs, & against every person whatsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. in Witness whereof I have set my hand & seal this 15th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifteen, & in the thirty eighth year of American Independence.
