State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I James McCarty of the State and district aforesaid For and in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand dollars to me paid by Charles Pitts of the State aforesaid and District of Pendleton have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release unto the said Charles Pitts a Plantation or tract of land containing by estimation one Thousand and forty four acres (more or less) It being part of a tract granted to James Moringore for less Thousand acres bearing date January 1st 1785 Recorded in grant Book B.C.B.W. page 288 thence part of S^E tract conveyed round to S. McCarty now from J. McCarty to J. Charles Pitts - Beginning at a Red Oak站在 a small creek thence N 15 E. to a red oak, thence S. 75 E. to red oak of Geo French line, thence on S. French line to a Hickory tree S. 15 W. to a Stake on the River, thence up the meander of the River to the mouth of the Creek, including the Island, thence up the Creek to the beginning which parcel or tract of land as above described including the dwelling House Grid Mill together with all the right members there of tenement and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or attending to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Charles Pitts his heirs and assigns, forever; And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises to the said Charles Pitts his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my Hand and Seal this 17th day of September in the year of our Lord 1807 and in the thirty second year of the Independence of the United States of America
