Much have granted bargain sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Thomas Crayton all these two certain lots of land in the village of Pleasantburg at Greenville Court house whereon the said Thomas Crayton now lives known and distinguished in the plan or chart of the said village by the numbers seven and eight (No. 7 & 8) and adjoining each other. Beginning at a stake corner at the corner of the Public square, running thence South fifteen and a half degrees West fifty two and an half feet to a stake thence North seventy four and an half degrees West two hundred feet to a stake thence North fifteen and an half degrees East one hundred and fifty two and an half feet to a stake thence South twenty four and an half degrees East two hundred and fifty two and an half feet to a stake thence South fifteen and an half degrees West one hundred feet to a stake thence North seventy four and an half degrees West fifty two and an half feet to the Beginning. supposed to contain one acre and an half to the same more or less being the same lots which I bought at Sheriff's sale as the property of Robert and Joseph Black as may appear by the Sheriff's title to me for the same on Record in the Clerk's office of Greenville District in Book 3^d Page 1189.
