or persons whomsoever shall lawfully claim the same at any part thereof

this 11<sup>th</sup> of Jan'y 1809. signed & Delivered in the presence of John H. Joyce Edmond Griffin Joseph T. Roach  
South Carolina Greenville district. Personally came John H. Joyce before  
me the subscribing Justice and being duly sworn maketh oath that he  
saw Joseph Roach sign seal and acknowledge & deliver the within  
deed of conveyance to Horatio Griffin for the use and purpose therein  
mentioned and that Edmond Griffin was a subscribing witness with  
himself to the same. Sworn and subscribed to before me this 11<sup>th</sup> day of

510 State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Robert Cooke of  
Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of eighteen  
hundred dollars to me paid by Sam'l Pickett of the State and district  
aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Sam'l Pickett all that  
valuable land or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville district  
on the east side of North fork of Saluda some times called Chehewa  
river Beginning at a stake on the bank of the said river near the mouth of  
the Spring Branch ditch near some large rocky stones N. 83 E. 23° 70'  
to a dead black oak corner, the same being the beginning corner of the  
land conveyed to me by William Lynch on the ninth day of October in the  
year of our Lord 1803. thence N. 55 E. 16. 40 to a red oak corner thence N. 3 E.  
19. 75 to a post oak corner thence N. 55 W. 6. 50 to two black Jacks, thence  
N. 21<sup>1</sup>/2 W. 6. 70 to a stake by a red oak stump thence N. 31<sup>1</sup>/2 W. 32 to a spanish  
oak corner thence N. 80<sup>1</sup>/4 W. 5. 40 to a dead pine thence N. 8. W. 12 to a post  
oak corner thence S. 82 W. 38. 50 to a stake on the bank of the river  
thence down the said river with the meandering thereof agreeable to a plat  
of surveying certified by William H. Cooke deputy Surveyor of Greenville  
district on the fifth day of March in the year of our Lord 1816 to the  
beginning - including the plantation wherein said Robert Cooke  
now lies and containing by estimation four hundred and seven  
acres be the same more or less, and being part of two surveys of land  
one of which was granted to Sam'l M. Elkanay the sixteenth day of  
July in the year of our Lord one thousand and seven hundred and Eighty  
four by his excellency Benj. Grirard Governor of the State of S. Carolina  
his grant calling for four hundred acres of land recorded in the secretary  
office in Grant book Z. L. 14 page 94 as by referenced thence will fully  
appear the above described plantation and parcel of land being by the said  
Sam'l M. Elkanay conveyed to Elias Earle by lease and release executed  
on the fourth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven  
hundred and Eighty nine and by the said Elias Earle conveyed to me by deed  
of conveyance executed the eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and ninety eight and recorded in the clerk's office of  
Greenville as by reference thence will fully appear in book D page 526 and 527.
