532 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Edwards of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of six hundred dollars to me paid by Gowen Harris of Greenville district in the State aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Gowen Harris all that Plantation or tract of land where Richard Bradley & Gowen Harris now lives, it being a tract of land originally Surveyed for Eli Kosmer containing two hundred and ninety nine acres, beginning at a Spanish Oak on the Waggon road leading from Greenville Courthouse to Spartaubing Church, running from thence N. 20 E 61.25 to a black Oak thence N. 75. 14.50 to Post Oak on Henry Benions line, thence S. 26. E 19. to a black Oak on Benions line, thence N. 60 E 9.50 to black Oak on Benions line, thence S. 45 E 41.50 to a Stick on Johnsons line, thence along said line S 73 W. 32 to the Waggon road, thence with the meander of the road to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the right, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Gowen Harris his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Gowen Harris his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
