 Harrison of the State and district aforesaid have granted bargained
 sold & delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & deliver on
 the said Isham Harrison all that parcel or tract of land containing
 one hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less being
 part of a tract originally granted to the Meeks on the waters of Mountain
 Creek of Saluda River whereon Jesse Hervey family live and on South
 side of the Road leading from Maxwell's Bridge to Greenville to house
 sitting and bounding as will appear by reference to a deed from Jesse
 Hervey to myself dated on the Eighteenth day of January one thousand eight
 hundred and five. Together with all and singular the rights members
 Accoutments & appertinances to the said premises or in any wise apper-
 taining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned unto the said Harrison his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby
 bind myself heirs Executors & admors. to warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Isham his heirs and
 assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against every
 other person whomsoever Lawfully claiming the same or any part
 thereof provided nevertheless that if the said John H. Harrison
 has made and executed hereto fore titles for the said land to James
 Harrison Senr. in his lifetime then & in that case this deed to be null &
 void otherwise to remain in full force. In witness whereof I have here
