 tenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred & Sixteen test -

 Do grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the S^r. Henry
 Robertson all that tract or parcel of land containing two
 -nty. Acre be the same more or less Situated lying and
 being in the District of Greenville on both Sides of Armstrong
 Creek part of a tract of land formerly the property of Joseph
 Reasmore and conveyed to me by S^r. Reasmore beginning on
 a white Oak Corner Conditional between James Robertson &
 Said Henry Robertson thence down Said Branch to Armstrong Creek
 thence down Said Creek to a white oak Corner new maid between
 & Robertson thence a conditional line to a hickory corner on the East Side
 of Said Creek thence up Said Creek to a Stake on the west Side of Said Creek thence
 a conditional line to a Black Oak Corner on James Robertson line thence with
 Said Robertson to the beginning Corner Together with all & Singular the rights
 members hereditaments & appertinances to the S^r. premises belonging or in any wise
 Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & Singular the premises before men
 - into the Said Henry Robertson his heirs & assigns forever and I do here by bind my
 self
