Earle of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in Consideration of One hundred Dollars to me paid by David Henning of the District & State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant bargain Sell and release unto the Said David Henning two lots of Land containing one acre (more or less) Situate in the Village at Greenville Court house known & distinguished in the plan or Chart of the S<sup>d</sup> Village by the Numbers forty nine and fifty (N<sup>o</sup> 49 & 50) lying North of Said Henning, lots beginning at a Stake on the East Side of main Street at S<sup>d</sup> Henning Corner running thence South Seventy four and a half degrees East three hundred fifty two and a half feet to a Stake thence North fifteen and a half degrees East one hundred feet to a Stake - thence ~~thence~~ <sup>thence</sup> North 7 1/2 degrees W. 332 feet to a Stake thence S. 15 1/2 degrees W. 100 feet to the beginning being the same Lots which I bought from Lemuel J. Alton as may appear by deed bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> September 1815 & recorded in Book 3 page 469. Together with all and Singular the rights members <sup>hereditaments</sup> and appertinances to the S<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and Singular the premises before mentioned unto the Said David Henning his heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and Singular the S<sup>d</sup> premises unto the S<sup>d</sup> David Henning his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & Seal this twelfth day of April in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & sixteen 1816 of American Independance. Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of Wm. Holcombe, R. M. Earle, Geo. W. Earle South Carolina Greenville District Personally came Wm. Holcombe before me the Subscribing Justice and made oath that he saw Geo. W. Earle sign Seal & deliver the within deed of conveyance to David Henning for the uses & purposes in it mentioned, and that Robinson Earle was a Subscribing <sup>Witness</sup> with him self to the same. Hammett and by the Said Hammett lately sold and conveyed to me bounded on the W<sup>th</sup> Side by lands lately belonging to Col. Lemuel Alton on the S<sup>th</sup> West and South Sides by lands belonging to the Said Allen R. Parkers together with all and Singular the Rights members hereditaments and appertinances to the S<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and Singular
