part being originally granted to Robert Ramsey on the 4th day of
December 1786 the other part being originally granted to Jefe Guin
the 3^d of August 1801 Situated and lying in the district aforesaid on
Branch of Keedy River, containing Seventy acres of land be the
same more or less, beginning on a post oak on a direct line between
said Kelly and Adam Barroth's line, Running thence N. 77
