The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I George W. Earle of Greenville District & State of said in consideration of six hundred and twenty five dollars to me paid by William Joney of the same place have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents bargain sell & release unto the said William Joney a certain House Plot of land supposed to contain about one half acre situated in the Village of Pleasantburg at Greenville Court House being the same lot which I purchased at Sheriffs Sale as the property of Cyrus Earle dec'd being the north Ends of Lots N<sup>o</sup> 11 & 12, Beginning at a Stake at the corner of Public Square adjoining Mr. Wickliffs, running thence North Seventy Four & one half degrees West, two hundred & Eight & one half feet across said Lots N<sup>o</sup> 11 & 12 to a Stake, thence N. 15<sup>o</sup> E. Fifty two & one half feet to a Stake, thence S. 74<sup>o</sup> E. two hundred feet to a Stake, thence S. fifteen & one half west fifty two & one half feet on the side of the Publick Square to the Beginning (the North End of said House being a few feet on S. Street) also two other lots adjoining the above mentioned, being the same which I bought of John B. Blackwell, known & distinguished in the Plan of said Village by the numbers ten & thirteen (N<sup>o</sup> 10 & 13) the N<sup>o</sup> 10 beginning on a Stake running S. 15<sup>o</sup> W. one hundred & Fifty two & one half feet to a Stake thence North 74<sup>o</sup> W. one hundred feet to a Stake, thence S. 15<sup>o</sup> E. 152<sup>o</sup> feet to a Stake, thence S. 74<sup>o</sup> E. 100 feet to the Beginning. N<sup>o</sup> 13 Beginning on a Stake thence South & twenty four & one half East one hundred and one & one half feet to a Stake, thence S. 15<sup>o</sup> W. one hundred and forty feet to a Stake, thence S. 74<sup>o</sup> W. 157<sup>o</sup> feet to a Stake, thence N. 15<sup>o</sup> East 140 feet to the Beginning, the two last containing one acre in the same manner, together with all & singular the Rights more by Constitution and Appointment owing to the said premises, belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, To have and to hold aforesaid & to hold aforesaid & to hold aforesaid unto the said William Joney his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to support and for ever defend, give and enjoy unto the said Joney his heirs and assigns against myself and all others claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, in any way and in all things, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1815.
