by James M^cDaniel of the district and State aforesaid have Granted bargained
& sold unto the said James M^cDaniel all those ten parcels or tracts of land
situated lying & being in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of the Golden
Pond bounded as follows beginning at the fork of the branch on Jeremiah
Smiths old line running S^o 90 W^o 10 chs and line to a Stake on Nathaniel
Pondlettons land and from thence N^o 45 W^o 31 chs 50 lks and land to a
post oak on Jeremiah Smiths old line & thence N^o 60 E^o 11 chains 75 links
on said Smiths line to a post oak on Josiah Payms Line thence S^o 70 E^o 30
chains 75 links on S^o Payms line to a red oak thence on said Payms line S^o 60
E^o 16 chs 50 lks to a line on the branch first mentioned thence with the branch
to the beginning containing one hundred and four acres more or less also
one tract or parcel of land beginning at a white oak running S^o 60
E^o 25 chs. to a Stake from thence S^o 52 W^o 6 chs 50 lks to a Spanish
oak from thence N^o 75 W^o 29 chs. to a Stake from thence N^o 10 E^o 10
