43 State of South Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Philip Davis of the one part for & in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars cash in hand to me paid by David Terry of the other part both of the State and district aforesaid have granted Bargained Sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain Sell and release unto the said David Terry all and singular the whole of the land owned by sd. Davis in the district aforesaid containing first one tract of one hundred acres be the same more or less Purchased of Edward Stringer by sd. Davis lying & being on both sides of the west fork of the Beaver dam creek & Chickeree River of Saluda River being part of Survey of Land granted to Martin Adams & runs as follows, VIZ. beginning on a wh. ch. 5X on the N.W. side of the River Running thence on S to a Stake 3X N 34 W 40 to a wh. ch. 3X S 36 E 75 to white oak 3X thence to a Stake N 34 E 40 to wh. ch. thence onto the Beginning; Secondly a tract of Fifty six acres be the same more or less on the same waters Beginning on a hickory 3X & running N 56 W. 8 to wh. ch. 3X S 34 W 40 to a mountain oak 3X thence a strait line to a conditional Pine 3X on the Back line N 34 E to the beginning; being part of a tract granted to John Moor, Third & lastly The tract or parcel of Land purchased by sd. Davis of Tho. M. Harris for which the said Davis hath the sd. M. Harris's deed of conveyance for one hundred acres on the said water adjoining the above described Land & running agreeable to (S. deed)
