South Carolina Greenville District This Indenture made <sup>this</sup> twenty <sup>fourth</sup> day of February Eighteen hundred and Seventeen between Young Griffin of Greenville District of the one part & Frederick Little of the other part Witnesseth that the said Young Griffin for the sum of Six hundred dollars to him in hand paid by S<sup>r</sup> Frederick Little the receipt whereof he has and doth acknowledge and by these presents hath bargained granted and sold with by these presents deliver and confirm unto the S<sup>r</sup> Frederick Little his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land Situate and bounding as follows, on the South Side of South Tyger river beginning on a Sapogras corner on the bank of the river thence on down his Land thence on Nichols Land to a red oak corner thence on John Balys line to a Stake corner on Shattens line thence along S<sup>r</sup> line to Young Pools line thence along S<sup>r</sup> line to the river thence down the meander of the S<sup>r</sup> river to the beginning all together containing three hundred and twenty acres be the same more or less, with all houses fences or <sup>lands</sup> woods and in woods water courses, Thereunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining thereto have and to hold the S<sup>d</sup> tract or parcel of land and all the before mentioned premises unto the S<sup>r</sup> Frederick Little & his heirs forever in do covenant & forever defend the said tract of land & premises unto the said Frederick Little his heirs and assigns forever in witness where of the said Young Griffin hath set his hand & fixed his seal the day & year above mentioned, Moses Swafford, This Howard Young Griffin South Carolina Greenville District, Personally came Moses Swafford before me the Subscribing Justice & being duly sworn made oath that he saw Young Griffin sign seal & deliver the within deed to Frederick Little for the use and purposes therein mentioned & that John Howard was a subscribing Witness with himself to the same.
