ased then to the beginning including one hundred acres together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurten  
ances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incidental or appertaining  
g, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said Abraham Cox and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
Executors & adm<sup>r</sup>s to warrant and forever defend all and singular the  
premises before mentioned unto the S<sup>r</sup>. Abraham Cox his heirs & assigns  
forever against myself & my heirs & against Every other person whom  
ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. in
