= se, unto the said Mathew Hudson & to his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract  
or parcel of land situated lying and being in the district and State aforesaid,  
on branches of mountain creek waters of Enore River containing four hun  
= dred and seventy acres (more or less) being a part of a tract of land belonging  
to the Estate of Forest Hudson Decd. and drawn by Joseph Hudson one of the heirs  
of Forest Hudson as his lot and share of the real Estate of Said deceased as may  
appear by reference to the return of the commissioners appointed by the court of  
Greenville to divide the said land & now filled in the clerk's office of the said court.  
Beginning at a conditional black oak corner thence E 74.50 to a post oak corner  
thence N 40 to a Stake corner thence N 66 W 82 to a Stake corner the S 2 E 74 to the  
conditional Black oak corner of (lot N. 5) Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise inci
