South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I William Ford of Greenville District & State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Alexander McKinny of the district aforesaid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained, sold releas conveyed & confirmed by these presents do grant bargain sell releas convey & confirm unto the said Alexander McKinny his heirs & assigns all that Plantation tract or parcel of land wherein I now live containing by estimation four hundred acres be the same more or less, Situate lying and being in Greenville district aforesaid on the branches of Cheechawee River waters of Saluda River and runs as follows (that is to say) Beginning on a white oak the beginning corner of George Salmon old Survey thence North Eighty Seven degrees west to white oak Jackson's corner thence with S Jackson's line to a Stake on Thomas McCarrel's line thence with said line South sixty five degrees East to a poplar on said McCarrel's corner thence South twenty five degrees west to a branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a line of part of
