E. Corner thence North thirty six chains to a Post Oak, Gowen's Corner, thence North seventy eight degrees West four chains to a Stake, thence to the beginning corner a Locust, being composed of the whole of a tract of land granted to John Gowen by his Excellency Charles Pinkney Esquire, and conveyed to Laban Loftis by Sheriff's Title, for John Wood - And part of a tract of land granted to William Davis, by his excellency William Mouttrie and conveyed from Davis, to John Davison, from Davison to Henry Bates, from Bates to William Early and from Early to Laban Loftis. and part of a tract of land granted to William Lynch and conveyed round to Sipe Baker from Baker to Laban Loftis.
