

or bequeath unto my beloved friends Nathaniel Jackson & Samuel Hunt a certain parcel of land laying round about Goodgions meeting house in said district, Beginning at a Stake and East direction from said house, running West five Roods and five links to a Stake, thence N^o Four Roods & five lks Crossing of the Toogals road to a Stake, thence an East direction five Roods and five links, crossing the Toogals road and Goodgions road to a Stake thence Crossing Goodgions road to the beginning, supposed to contain Twenty four Roods (be the same more or less) which said piece of land I grant release or bequeath unto the above named Nathaniel Jackson & Samuel Hunt in Trust, and as Trustees, for said meeting house or neighbourhood round about said meeting house or to their successors in Office and the appurtenances therunto belonging, for a place of Public Worship, for ever (reserving to myself Executors or Administrators the entire right or title to said piece of land if the neighbourhood should fail to occupy said place for one whole year together as a place of Public Worship) utterly debarring of myself my heirs Assigns Executor or Administrators from ever thereafter claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, by any prior or subsequent Will, release or any other way, whatever. In testimony whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this third Day of May in the Year one thousand eight hundred and seven teen.
