of South Carolina, have granted bargained sold and
released, and by these Presents do grant Bargain and
Sell unto the said Waddy Thompson a certain tract or
parcel of land Containing One acre, Begining on
the road near to the corner of said Waddy Thompson,
house on his own and said Vardrys line, six chains & 2
links from their red Oak bush Corner and runs S. 13 W.
3 ch. 60 links along the road to a Stake in said road
thence S. 73 E. 3 ch. 16 links to a Stake near a long black
Oak thence N. 13 E. 2 chains 72 links to a Stake on
the begining line, thence to the begining. Together
with all and singular the rights and privileges here-
ditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have & to hold
all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever.
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & admis-
trator to warrant & for ever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs
& assigns against myself my heirs & assigns, & against
