 which I am entitled to under his Will aforesaid,
 with the increase of the property aforesaid, to my
 Brother-in-law John Young his heirs Executors and
 assigns - And I do further Contract and agree that
 should the property now in the possession of my Mother
 Elizabeth Salmon be delivered to the Legatee in order
 to effect a division in conformity with the Will
 aforesaid, then it is agreed and my desire that John
 Salmon and William Salmon Exors. of the Will of
 John Salmon Deceased, should deliver all the

 or representatives, and I the said Walker Salmon for
