payments whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold deliv-  
ered conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and  
deliver and confirm unto the said Johnson Bain his heirs and assigns forever  
part <sup>10</sup> of a tract of land that was granted to Joseph McGaule bounded as  
follows beginning on a Locus and running south a croft thence to the
