Edwards of the district aforesaid have granted bargained sold

unto the said Thomas Edwards a Tract or Parcel of Land laying & being  
in the district aforesaid on the Waters of Middle Tyger River beginning  
at a white oak on the road leading to Greenville Court House and  
Running thence N 59 ch<sup>d</sup> to a post oak thence N 80 E 29 ch<sup>d</sup> to a pine  
thence N 10 E 16 ch<sup>d</sup> 50 links to a white oak station tree on the side of  
a Branch thence up the meanders of the same to a white oak thence  
N 50 W 70 chains to a pine knot on Woods line thence with his line \$60.44  
to a black oak known by Landfords corner tree thence \$65 E 11 chains to a  
oak thence \$58 E 27 ch<sup>d</sup> to pine knot thence \$40 W 44 chains to a white
