Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Waddy Thompson a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the district of Greenville aforesaid on both sides of Richland Creek near the Court House originally granted to Mr. Maser & by him conveyed to the said Joseph Dill containing two hundred Acres be the same more or less and hath such shape forms and marks as the plat annexed to the original grant represents. Together with all and singular the rights members tenements and appurtenances therunto belonging in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned to the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself & my Successors to warrant & firmly defend the said premises unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns against me my heirs & Successors and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand & Seal this 18<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven.
