Dollars to me in hand paid by Wm Cannady of the
State aforesaid Lawrance District I have Bargained Sold &
by these Presents do Grant Bargain Sell & Convey unto the
Cannady all my Right Title and Claim to a certain Tract
or Parcel of Land supposed to contain Six Hundred Acres
of Land Situate in Greenville District in the State aforesaid
on both sides of the S Fork of Durhams Creek including
The Plantation whereon George Flannagan Formerly lived
and originally Granted to William Steel Bounding on
William Sonis and William Cannady Together with all
& singular the rights members Heirs Tamers and
Appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise Incid-
-ent or appertaining thereunto into the only proper use
and behoof of him the said William Cannady his heirs
Executors Admors & Assigns against my self my heirs
and Admors and no further as to be understood that
said James Kilgore only Sells & Conveys his right Title
& Claim Witness my hand & seal this 29th October 1804
and in the 29th Year of the Independance of the United
State of America
