Benj. Griffith Esquire: Situate lying and being in the
 West part of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of
 ruddy Mount and Richland Creek on the North East side & said
 is being originally granted in five different Grants to wit
 a grant to Isaac Bruce for one Hundred Acres dated the 1st
 of March 1786 one other grant to said Bruce for one hundred
 and sixty Acres dated the 7th of August 1786 one other grant to
 said Bruce for two Hundred and forty four Acres dated
 the 5th of November 1792 a grant to Daniel Wilbanks for
 one Hundred and thirty eight Acres dated 1st of December
 1794 and conveyed from said Wilbanks to said Bruce
 and a grant to Archibald Fowler dated in 1798 part
 of which to wit one Hundred and thirty six Acres was con-
 veyed from said Fowler to said Fling the 20th day of
 January 1818 Bounded on the S^o W. by Joram Stokes and
 said Greens land on the West by said Greens land on the north
 by John Watsons land on the North East by said Greens and
 Sullivan's land and on the East by Fowlers and Andersons
 Land. Beginning on a Stake corner adjoining Stokes land running
 thence S^o W. 27^o Ch. 50 links to a Red Oak thence N^o 30 W. 90 chains
 to a Pine stump thence N^o 60 E. 28 ch to a black Oak thence N^o
 75 E. 20 Ch. to a Stake thence S^o W. 18 ch to a Stake thence North
 one chain to a Stake thence N^o 30 E. 45 Ch to a Stake thence N^o 34
 W. 38.50 to a Black Oak thence N^o 65 E. 15 ch to a Dogwood
 thence S^o E. 30 E. 19 ch to a black Oak thence S^o 10 E. 22.75 to a Dogwood
 by a dead white Oak thence S^o 15 W. 20 Ch. 75 links to a pine by a
 dead Red Oak thence S^o 17 E. 58 ch. to a pine thence S^o 80 E. 32 ch.
 to a theory thence S^o 63 W. 62 ch. 75 links to a black Oak thence
 N^o 32 W. 1.25 to the Beginning Together with all and singular the
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to
 have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns for ever. and
 I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administ-
 rators to Warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 premises before mentioned (including the Cotton Machine
 & serew) unto the said Elisha Green his heirs and assigns
 against myself and my heirs claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. in witness whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand & seal this Twentieth just day of January in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eighteen
 and in the forty second year of the American Independence
