State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Harris of the one part for & in consecration of the sum of Seven Hundred Dollars Cash in hand to me paid by William Cannady of the other part both of the State & District aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold & Released & by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said William Cannady all and singular five hundred Acres of land including the House Plantation Mill &c. Where the said parties now Live in the said District first beginning at Sawwood Stake on the waters of Elises Creek thence N 70 W 50. Chain to a Stake N 46 E. 6 1/2 to a Stake S 15 W 45 to a Stake S 40 W. 6 to a Stake S 15 W 40 to the begining said to contain 188 acres Being the land purchased by said Benjamin of Zachariah Harris also 2nd by Bought of Zachariah Harris in the same Deed Beginning at a pine Stake on a Conditional Line agreed on by Ephraim Ellis and Thomas Rayburn and thence to a conditional pine Stake thence to a Dogwood Tree with a Due course to a Line S 33 N 49 W to a Chestnut Stake N 15 E. to a black Gum Stake S 45 E. to a pine Stake S 45 W. to the begining 2nd Tract S. to contain 145 acres bought by Georg Blaney to said Harris beginning and W 83 N 74 E. 20 to a Stake S 33
