State of South Carolina Greenville District Know all men by these presents that Benjamin Harris of the one part for & in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars Cash in hand to me paid by William Kennedy of the other part both of the State & District aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release in to the said William Kennedy all and singular five hundred Acres of land including the House Plantation Mill &c. Where the said parties now lives in the said District first beginning at Sawmills Stake on the waters of Eli's Creek running thence N 70 W 50 chain to a pine 3x N 46 E 64 to a pine 3x S 15 W 45 to a pine 3x S 40 W 6 to a pine 3x S 15 W 46 to the beginning said to contain 188 acres being the land purchased by said Benjamin of Zachariah Harris also 2nd by bought of Zachariah Harris in the same Deed Beginning at a pine 3x on a Conditional Line agreed on by Ephraim Elks and Thomas Rayburn and running thence to a conditional pine 3x thence to a Dogwood tree with a due course to a pine 3x N 49 W to a Chestnut 3x N 15 E to a black Gum 3x 5 to a pine 3x S 45 W to the beginning ^{3rd} tract S to contain 145 acres bounded by George Elangof to said Harris Beginning and W 13x N 74 E 20 to a Red Oak 3x
