

 Originally granted to William Brandon, by grant bearing date the fifteenth
 day of October one thousand seven hundred & Eighty four, & conveyed by the
 Brandon to Jeremiah Stokes the twenty third of December One thousand
 seven Hundred & Eighty eight & this part conveyed from the said
 Jeremiah Stokes to John Stokes & from the said John Stokes to Levi Stokes &
 now from the said Levi Stokes to Jeremiah Stokes Junior together with all & singu-
 -lar the rights members Hereditaments & appertinances to the said premises
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To Have & To Hold all &
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Stokes Junior
 his heirs & assigns for ever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &
 Administrators to Warrant & Convey defend all & singular the said premis-
 -es unto the said Jeremiah Stokes Junior his heirs & assigns against myself
 & my heirs & against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claim-
 -ing or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand & seal this
 Sixth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred
 & sixteen & in the fortieth year of the Sovereignty & Independence of
 the United States of America Signed sealed & delivered in the presence
 of Wm. Mason

 same sworn & subscribed to before me this 6 of May 1816

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I George
 Unaiwood of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina for & in consideration
 of the sum of, Five Hundred & Twenty Dollars to me in hand paid by
 Jeremiah Stokes Junior of the State & District aforesaid have granted,
 Bargained, sold, & released & By these presents do Grant, Bargain,
 Sell & release unto the said Jeremiah Stokes Junior a certain tract
 or parcel of land situate lying & being in the District aforesaid
 on Maple Creek a branch of Reedy River containing One Hundred &
 fifty Acres be the same more or less being part or half of a tract of
 land originally granted to John Watson, twenty seventh day of
 November 1784. Beginning on a post oak bush 37 running thence
 S. 65. W. 27 ch. 38 links to a red oak 37 being a beginning corner of the
 original tract, thence S. 25. E. 54 ch & 77 links to a post oak 37 thence
 N. 65. E. 27 ch. 38 links to a live oak stake 37 on the dividing line of
 the said tract thence N. 25 W. 54 ch. 77 links to the beginning post oak
 bush together with all & singular the rights, members, Hereditaments
 & appertinances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise
