Thomas Morrow do thereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the above described land & premises to the S. William Ashmore his heirs & assigns from all claims that now is or may be made by any person whatsoever claiming the same or any part thereof I witness I hereunto set my hand & seal this 19th day of July one thousand Eight hundred & Seventeen, signed & delivered in presence of Amos Richardson

Cox before me & being sworn as the law directs saith that he was present and saw Thomas Morrow sign Seal & deliver the within deed of conveyance to William Ashmore for the uses & purposes therein mentioned also that he saw Amos Richardson subscribe his name as a witness to the same at the same time with himself sworn to before this 26 day of July 1817

285 This Indenture made this twenty eight day of June in the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six between John Ashmore of the State of South Carolina Greenville County of the one part & William Ashmore of the State & County afores^d of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Ashmore for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds lawful money to him in hand paid by said William Ashmore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John Ashmore hath bargained & sold by these presents doth bargain sell alien release and confirm unto said William Ashmore his heirs & assigns forever the land to be conveyed is situated in the State & County aforesaid on the west side of Rocky creek waters of Ruddy River it being a part of a tract of land conveyed from N. Cannon Hudson's William Home from said Home to John Ashmore the land to be conveyed begins on a gum corner on the west bank of said
