Mary Powell spring branch thence down said branch to the Mill creek thence down S. creek to its confluence with Saluda river including one acre more or less on the north side of S. Mill creek & adjoining S. Mill for the use of the same. Together with all & singular belongings to the S. Langford premises unto the S. Arary Huff to him his heirs & assigns to have & to hold forever I the S. Edmund Wood do hereby bind myself my heirs & assigns to warrant & forever defend the above longained premises unto the S. Arary Huff his heirs & assigns forever & against myself my heirs & assigns & every other person or persons lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. In testimony whereof I do hereunto affix my hand & seal & make a delivery of the same this 17<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1818. Signed sealed & delivered in the presence of Julius Huff.
