347 State of South Carolina know all men by these presents that I Thomas Brasher of the district of Greenville & State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me paid by John Ashmore of the district & State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & released & by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said John Ashmore a tract or part of a tract of land containing two hundred acres, more or less lying in the district aforesaid, on a branch on the east side of theuddy fork creek originally granted to Aquilla Brasher & a part of a tract originally granted to Thomas Brasher, reference being had to the original grants will more fully appear. The said two hundred acres of land more or less is laid out unto the said John Ashmore as follows: Beginning at a lightwood stake on the original line running East to a branch thence running up said branch to a poplar thence on a conditional line to a second conditional line thence running N. E. way, on the said conditional "line" to a pine corner: thence running along the original line adjoining George Greegston to a post oak corner then on 3^d original line to a black oak corner, thence on the original line to a stake corner on Croft's land thence on the 2^d line to a black oak stump thence on 2^d line to a post oak corner, thence Eastward on a conditional line to a Spanish oak station on the original line thence up the original line to the beginning including two hundred acres, more or less together with all & singular the rights, members, hereditaments & appurtenances to the 3^d premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining thereunto to have & to hold all & singular the 3^d premises before mentioned; unto the 3^d John Ashmore, against myself my heirs & assigns & all other persons who at Sover. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty third day of July one thousand eight hundred & seven Signed sealed & delivered in presence of J. M. Daniel
