Ligon part of that tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the district of Greenville aforesaid on the North side of Saluda River containing Twenty seven Acres be the same more or less being part of that tract or parcel of Land originally granted to John Edmondson by his Excellency Joseph Mifflin the fifth day of December 1814 as appears by a grant recorded in the Secretary's office in Grant Book H No 8 page 314 beginning on a Stake on Edwards & Harrison line thence S 71 W 40 to a crab apple tree corner on the River thence S 75 E 18.2 to a hickory thence
