he the said Wm Austin hath for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds
sterling to him in hand paid by the said Johnathan Davis. The receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold remised released conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell make over convey and confirm
unto the said Johnathan Davis a plantation or tract of land containing one
hundred acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville County on the
waters of Durbin's Creek branches of Broad river it being the upper end of the
above mentioned tract beginning at a black oak corner of the old tract
running thence N 35 E to a black oak corner of said old tract thence on the
old line to a black jack corner from thence through the old tract by
a line of marked trees to a red oak then to the beginning supposed to
include one hundred acres be the same more or less with all
and singular the rents profits & issues with all the appurtenances there
unto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the only absolute & proper
use and behoof of him the said Johnathan Davis his heirs or assigns &
he the said Johnathan Davis his heirs executors administrators or assigns shall
and may from time to time and at all times hereafter have, hold, use,
occupy, possess and enjoy so plantation or tract of land free and clear
from any manner, trouble, hinderance, molestation, interruption or
denial of him the said Wm Austin his heirs or assigns & lastly he the
said Wm Austin from himself his heirs executors Administrators or
assigns or any other person under him, but no further unto the said
Johnathan Davis his heirs executors administrators or assigns the said
tract of one hundred acres of land be the same more or less shall
and will warrant and forever defend. In witness whereof he the said
Wm Austin hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day & date first
