This Indenture made this sixteenth of June 1815, between Samuel Peden of the State of South Carolina Greenville district of the one part, and James Peden of the State and district aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Samuel Peden for & in consideration of the sum of five pounds lawfull money to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold, and by these Presents doth bargain and sell release and confirm unto James Peden forever, all that Plantation or tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less, it being a part of a tract of 19 hundred acres originally granted to John Peden, situated in Greenville district and State aforesaid, the land to be conveyed begins as follows (Viz) Beginning at a black Oak 8x on the old bound ary line, along said line to another corner by a Pond, then N. 80 West 57 chains to a Stake 2x S. 10 W. to Russells corner, thence S. East to a red Oak corner of a tract of land of S^r Samuel Peden (338 acres) thence along said line to the beginning corner, which include the quantity of land to be conveyed; and the said Samuel Peden doth covenant and agree with the said James Peden that he will forever warrant and defend the above described 200 acres more or less, from himself his heirs executors Adm^r or Assigns, or any of them, together with all and singular appurtenances, hereditaments, amoliments, commodities, rents Issues & profits thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto, But to the only proper use behoof of him the s^r James Peden, his heirs executors, Administrators or assigns forever.
