For and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred and thirty dollars to them in hand paid by Joseph and William Barton said grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joseph and William Barton jointly certain plantations tracts or parcels of lands whereon the said Sotts then lived, on both sides of the sink hole fork of Tiger river, and Bartons fork of said river in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid, containing three hundred and forty acres more or less, bounded as by reference to the said deeds may appear. Now Know ye, that I the said William Barton in order to make division and partition of the said tracts of land between myself and the said Joseph Barton, and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by the said Joseph Barton, Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph Barton all my right title claim and demand what soever of in or to all and singular that part of the tracts of land above mentioned which lays on the South or South West side of the gap Creek road, and shoal path to a rock, thence a straight line to a White Oak, thence on a line of marked trees till it strikes the upper end of said lands, joining lands of Thomas Howard, cornering on a rock: beginning on the lower end of said land by the road, so as to make it the line between us up to the shoal path, then the path and marked trees as before mentioned to be the line between us from the road: supposed to contain two hundred and twenty five acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the said parts of the tracts above mentioned unto the said Joseph Barton his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend the said premises unto the said Joseph Barton his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and Seal this twenty sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen.
