Know all men by these Presents, that I Samuel Tarrant of Greenville district and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy five dollars to me paid by John Richardson of the same place, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Richardson all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred and seventy five acres more or less, it being part of a tract of land released from Robert Gellibaud to Mr. Pogue, and from said Pogue to Samuel Tarrant, and from him to said Richardson, bounded as follows beginning at a Stake on Bowie's ancient line, thence S. 73° 43' 56" on Joseph Read's old line to a Stake, thence S. E. 50° 26' 50" to a red Oak thence N. E. 45° 72 chains to a post Oak stump, thence S. E. 47° 25' to the beginning on Bowie's ancient line. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, & appurtenances, to have to the said Premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Richardson his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Premises unto the said John Richardson his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
