Holcombe & on the S. side by land surveyed for John Brazil beginning at a forked Chesnut & running thence S 50 E 10 ch. to a B.O. 3x S 70 E 42 to a hickory 3x N 50 E 13 to a pine 3x N. 20 E 39-50 ch. to a locus 3x N 54 E to a hickory 3x N 14 N. 17 to a chesnut 3x N 55 N. 25-50 to a chesnut 3x S 63 N 13 to a B.O. 3x S 10 E 14 to a white oak 3x S 17 E 6-50 to a hickory 3x S 9 N 14 to a chesnut 3x S 30 N. 5-25 to a B. gum 3x N 62 N 23 to a chesnut 3x S 32 N 37-50 ch. to the beginning containing two hundred & ninety three acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Sothelie & his heirs forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors, & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises from myself, my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof but from no other person or persons.
