in consideration of Three hundred dollars to me in hand paid  
by James Brown of the district and State aforesaid; Have granted  
bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bar-  
-gain sell and release unto the said James Brown, all that tract  
or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the district & State  
aforesaid, on the head waters of Ruddy Fork Creek, of Ruddy River.  
Containing two hundred and forty Acres, more or less, being a  
tract of Land originally granted to William Brasher, by his  
Excellency William Moultrie Esq Governor of South Carolina  
on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1786. bounded by lands of James  
Seaborn, William Cotton and Azariah Cookman. Together  
with all and singular the rights members incidents  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any  
wise incident or appurtenaining. To have and to hold all  
and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James  
Brown his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs Executors and adm<sup>r</sup> to warrant and forever defend all &  
singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James  
Brown his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs, and  
against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
