

The State of Georgia. Know all men by these presents that I Walter Knight
of the county of Richmond and City of Augusta in consideration of one
hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Charlotte Long
of the district of Greenville and State of S^c Carolina having granted,
bargained, sold and released & these presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release, unto the said Charlotte Long, all that tract, or parcel of
Land, situated lying and being in the district of Greenville & State of
S^c Carolina, lying on a branch of Maple Creek waters of Sandy river
& being part of a tract of Land awarded by Tho^s. Payne Sheriff of Greenville
district S^c Carolina to Jese & Asa Reed, and by the said Reed to me,
& known as No. 6 which tract was originally James Sealow's. —
Beginning on three poplars & running N. 75° E. to the west, to Hicks line
Stake X 3 S. 50° W. 6 ch. to a pine 3X thence S 20 W 30 ch. to a stake
thence S 42 to the east. 20 ch. to a stake, thence to the beginning.
Containing ninety two acres, more or less. Together all and singular
the rights, members, & hereditaments, & appurtenances, to the s^d premises
belonging, or in any way incident or appertaining. To have, and to
hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d
Charlotte Long her heirs & assigns, against myself and my heirs & against
every other person whomsoever claiming the same or any part
thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 21st day of December
Eighteen hundred & nineteen.

Witness Lester Richards, Asa Reed & Walter Knight 
South Carolina Greenville district. Asa Reed personally came

and saw Walter Knight assign and deliver the within deed of
conveyance to Charlotte Long for the use and purpose within
