dollars to me paid in hand have granted bargained & sold & released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto William
V. Roberts all that tract or parcel of land supposed to contain twenty
acres, be the same more or less, situate in Greenville district S. Carolina on
the north side of Clear Creek of South Sugar river. Beginning on Langley's
and R. Carters red oak corner by the old school house running thence
to a sweet gum in the old field thence up the pin race to a black gum
on the creek thence up the creek to a white oak thence to a black gum
corner on Langley's line thence S. line to the beginning. Together with
all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances
to said premises belonging or in any way incident or appertaining.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said W. V. Roberts, his heirs and assigns forever. I do hereby bind
myself my heirs, executor, & administrators to warrant and ever defend
all and singular the same premises unto the said W. V. Roberts, his heirs or
assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
