privileges, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
unto the said head of Sign river Church their successors or assigns forever
against myself my heirs, & assigns, & every other person, whomsoever lawfully
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
and seal this 21st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & eighteen & in the 42^d. year of American Independence.
Signed, sealed, & delivered in the presence of us.

what is therein, consisting of one pewter dish, one pewter basin, six
pewter plates, and twelve spoons, a set of tea cups & saucers, and
eight earthen plates, two mugs, one coffee pot, three tin buckets,
four tin cups, and one set of knives & forks, and one flesh fork, one
table, one pail, & two piggins, one churn, two washing tubs, one meal
barrett, bread tray, and sifter, one flour barrett, one flax wheel,
and one cotton wheel, one check reel, one smoothing iron, two
pots, one oven & one skillet, five chairs, one loom, four plows,
three pair of harrows, one chest, nine head of hogs and their
increas, three head of geese, and two weeding hoes, and one axe.
And I do bind myself, my heirs, exors. admors. & assigns to warrant
and forever defend the above stated articles, unto my s^d. daughter
