

any compulsion dread or fear of any person or persons whomsoever renounce  
release and favor relinquish unto the within named John Westfield  
Jund. his heirs and assigns all her interest and estate & also all her right  
and claim of dower of in & to all & singular the premises within mentioned  
and released. Given under my hand & seal this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 1820.


L. Tarrant J. P. Mary <sup>his</sup> West  
South Carolina Greenville district personally appeared John Townes before  
me and maketh oath that he saw Isaac West sign seal & deliver the  
within conveyance for the uses & purposes therein mentioned & that him-  
self & Rachel West in the presence of each other witnessed the due  
execution thereof. Sworn before me this 6<sup>th</sup> day of March 1820.

Greenville district and State aforesaid for an in consideration of the sum of three  
hundred & fifty dollars to me in hand paid by John Blankinship of the district &  
State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant  
bargain & sell unto the sd John Blankinship a plantation or tract of land  
lying and being situate in the district & State aforesaid on Maple Creek waters  
of reedy river it being a part of a tract granted to James Seaborn by his  
Excellency Tho<sup>s</sup> Pickens Esq<sup>r</sup> in the year 1798. and conveyed to W<sup>m</sup> Kelly  
then to the said John Butler the land to be conveyed begins on state runs  
S 42 E 24 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 ch<sup>s</sup> to a black oak or S 13. 63 to pine stump or S 32. 32: 79  
to pine or S 42 W 24: 67 to stake by Kellys fence then by conditional line  
or S 40 E to pine in the hollow near Griffins fence then up the sd hollow to the  
beginning including one hundred acres be the same more or less.

Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and  
appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise incident or  
appertaining. To have & to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the sd John Blankinship. And I do hereby bind myself  
my heirs Exors & admors to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the premises before mentioned unto the sd John Blankinship his heirs & assigns  
forever against myself & my heirs and against every other person whom-  
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
