 to a stake 3x thence S 5 W. 8. 50 to a poplar 3x bounding on the
 heirs of Jonathan Stone dec. thence S 85 E 5 to a pine 3x thence N 24
 W. 10. 25 to a stake 3x thence N 5 E 1 to a rock 3x bounding on
 W¹⁰ Stone's land thence N 62 W 20. 15 to a chestnut 3x bounded
 on George Grace's land thence S 45 W 12 to a hickory 3x thence N 67
 W. 7. 50 to a stake thence N 80 W 5 to a dogwood 3x thence S 5 W
 5 to a dogwood 3x crossing said creek, the last mentioned line

 McCollough his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind, my
 self my heirs, Exors. & administrators, to warrant and firm defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McCollough
 his heirs and assigns against my self and my heirs and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this second

 nineteen and in the 44th year of the American Independence
