Know all men by these presents that I John Bohannon of district & State aforesaid for due consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Burrell Pruitt have this day sold & by these presents do sell & release a certain tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less situated in district & State aforesaid & on Waters side of road near beginning Sweet gum station on S. bank of said creek on the original line of Cadwalader Jones line thence S.W. to a P.O. on said line thence S.E. on S. line to a P.O. thence eastward to a black Oak station thence on a direct line of measurement to a stake on a conditional line made between Tho^s. Dean & Geo. Simmons separating part of said tract conveyed to the S^d. Dean from thence N on said line to an ash corner standing on the bank on said original line thence S.W. on S. line to the beginning including forty acres more or less it being part of a tract of land originally granted to James Harrison Esq^r. by his excellency W^m. Moultrie the 2^d day of December 1795. The course of forty more or less (to make the afove mentioned one hundred acres. Beginning on an ash on the N. Bank of S. creek at a branch running up said bank to a maple corner thence N 29 E to a stake on the original line thence S 60 E on the original to a B.O. then S 30 W 25 to a stake thence to the beginning including in both one hundred acres more or less. Together with all & singular the rights, number, hereditaments & appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining therunto to the S^d. Burrell Pruitt his heirs & assigns to warrant & frown defend all & singular the premises above mentioned to the said Burrell Pruitt his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs & assigns and from every other person claiming the same or any part thereof.
