presents that I David Garrison of the state and district aforesaid  
for and of my own good free will have granted and released  
and by these presents do grant and release unto John Matfield Esq.  
of the said state and district all that tract or parcel of land  
containing fifty four acres more or less situated lying and being in  
the district of Greenville and on the waters of the Golden Goose Creek  
it being part of a tract of land originally surveyed and granted  
to Maj. John Bowie and divided to me by Moses Garrison on the 13<sup>th</sup>  
of March one thousand eight hundred and nine beginning on a stake  
corner of Richardsons line and running N. 23 E to the corner stake on  
Pudltons original line thence with said line to Bowies original corner  
stake on said line and from thence S 44 W to a corner stake & from  
thence S. 58 E to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular  
the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said  
premises belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto unto the said  
John Matfield Esq. his heirs and assigns forever <sup>against</sup> myself my heirs  
and assigns forever. Witness my hand this eight day May in the  
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & twenty and in  
the forty fourth year of the Independance of the United States
