less lying in the state and district aforesaid & both sides of the sink  
hole fork of middle tiger river. Beginning on a black oak in John  
Grist's land & running thence running east on S<sup>d</sup> Grist's line to chestnut corner  
thence on S<sup>d</sup> Grist's line to a post oak corner thence N 65. E to chestnut oak  
thence N 20 E 18 CH to a white oak; thence to a white oak sapling at  
the mouth of a little branch on the other side of the creek thence  
along S<sup>d</sup> branch to the head and thence to a spanish oak corner being  
made a conditional corner between George Gaham and Jonas Dawson thence  
along the line to where it intersects with John Peace's line thence along S<sup>d</sup> line  
to where it intersects with the old line again, thence along the said line  
to white oak that was made a conditional corner thence along a
