



situate in the district and state aforesaid on the south side of cam-
brake branch waters of enow river it being a part of a tract originally
granted to Wiah Conner and conveyed through different hands
to the said Wm Taylor the land to be conveyed. Begins on the
S^o bank of said branch in dogwood 3x runs S 3 E 73 ch to R.O. 3x
thence due W. 34 to stakes 3x thence N. 3 W 53 ch to poplar 3x thence down
the meander of said branch to the beginning including two
