four Boundings I E on land laid out by Robert Goodlette all
 other sides on vacant land at the time of the original survey thereof
 being made, which survey calls for two hundred acres but by reason of a
 Smith's land, Hood there is supposed to be twenty five acres cut off at the upper end of the side of the original
 conditional line made between said survey & added to the said
 land or plantation whom he formally binds the said line between
 them being a certain branch called the still house branch from
 where it crosses George Underwoods line to the mouth of the S branch
 from thence a direct course to a certain pine & from thence to the
 outward or back line & so to the beginning containing one hundred
 & seventy five acres by estimation. The other tract or parcel of land
 adjoining the above described land containing twenty five acres
 was land granted by Rob Goodlette to said Mr Grant the same
 being a part of the land or plantation now occupied by James
 Goodlette. Beginning at a post oak on Wm Bussons corner line the N
 side of the S fork of the three forks of Tyger river thence S 44 W to a
 Post oak Goodlette corner 34 ch^s thence S 46 E to a stake & pointing
 14:75 thence N 20 E 74 ch^s to the beginning, being as above mentioned
 twenty five acres of Rob Goodlette's tract of land conveyed by a
 from him to Wm Grant the 24th day of September AD one thousand
 seven hundred & ninety five as by the record of Surwith will
 more fully appear. Together (two hundred acres) with all &
 singular the above premises rights, manors, incidents, &
 appurtenances, or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the S
 Nipper Hood & his heirs, power and I do bind myself my heirs, exors
 and admors to warrant & forever defend the above described land
 from myself their, & from every other person or persons lawfully claiming
 the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand & seal this 30th day of
 December AD one thousand eight hundred and twenty.
