Henson on the twenty fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred and eighty five together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold all and singular the rights members hereditaments &c. to the said premises unto him the said Henson his heirs and assigns for ever against myself my heirs and assigns Every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof witness my hand and seal this fifth day of August one thousand eight hundred & fifteen & 4th year of American independence Sign: sealed and Executed in presence of us.
