granted bargain sold and released & by these presents do grant
bargain sell & release unto the said Wm S Dill a plantation tract
of land lying in Greenville District on wild cat creek of south by
and a branch of Elisha Thompson beaver dam creek of middle by
gen river it being original granted to James Gray & bearing date
the first day of February 1790 & hath such shape form & marks
are represented by a plat thereunto & recorded beginning on a post
oak thence S. 29 E 30 Chs. to a stake thence S. 75. W. to the creek
thence up the creek to a red oak a conditionally corner made by Gray
& Robert Carter thence to a black oak shows corner thence N. 20
W 22. 50. to a hickory thence N. 65 E 37 to a red oak thence a straight line to
the head of small branch thence down the branch to a poplar
popular thence to hold the waters from there to a gum corner
of said tract thence N 38 to the beginning it being a part of the
said tract granted to S James Gray by Estimation one hundred & eighty
acres the same more or less together with all and singular the rights
hereditaments & appertaining to the S D premises belonging or
in any wise appertaining to have & to hold all that part of
the original tract one hundred & eighty acres more or less unto Wm S Dill
his heirs Executors administrators & against for ever & I the S^d Alex
ander McDaniel do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors & admin
istrators to warrant & forever defend before mention premises
from the claim of all & every other person or persons whomsoever
or claiming or to claim lawfully in any part thereof in witness
whereof I the S^d Alexander McDaniel I have set my hand & af
fixed my seal this 1st of January one thousand Eight hundred
and nineteen signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us.
